National Identity themes & elements: Culture (Arabic Language, History & Heritage), Values (Respect, Compassion & Global / Cultural Understanding), and Citizenship (National belonging, volunteering & conservation).

- **Understanding UAE Culture:** Explore Arabic language, history, heritage, and values such as respect, compassion, and cultural understanding.
- **Symbolism and Traditions:** Examine UAE symbols (national anthem, flag, etc.) and customs (coffee and dates, greetings, etc.).
- Founding Fathers and Leadership: Get familiar with the names of founding fathers, current rulers and crown princes. Explore the role of H.H. Sheikh Zayed and other founding fathers in the formation of the UAE, and learn about the current ruler's initiatives.
- **UAE Facts:** Discover geographical, historical, and cultural facts about the UAE.
- Heritage and Landmarks: Explore UAE's heritage buildings, ancient civilizations, and famous landmarks.
